

Using Formal SignWriting in ASCII (FSW) with SignMaker 2017

Go to the “Dictionary” tab and you may see SignWriting in Unicode (SWU) like this:

To see the FSW, go to the “More” tab and then the “Preferences” sub-tab.

Notice SWU is black and FSW is gray. Click FSW so that FSW is black and SWU is gray.
